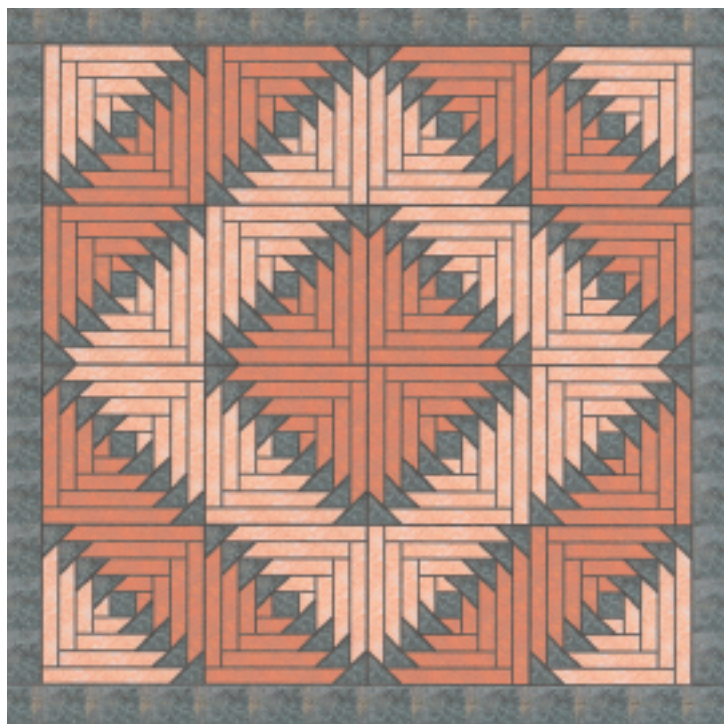


CORNERS IN THE CABIN

Medallion Wallhanging - 38" by 38"



Super EASY!

Just plop some corners on the:
FOLDY STUFF - LOG CABIN

Yardages -

Muslin (blocks & borders - 1 5/8 yard

Centers & Corners - 1 yard

Light Side - 1 1/8

Dark Side - 1 1/4

Border - 1/2 yard

Backing - 1 1/8

Cutting: - (See pattern, 7 1/2" block)

Triangles - cut 128 squares, 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

Border - cut border 3 1/2" wide

Adding Triangles:

1. Fold 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares in half to form triangles. Press, being careful not to stretch the bias fold.
2. Pin on desired corners as each row is completed. These are generally added to the corners that have a fabric change
3. Proceed with next row. The triangle will automatically be sewn in place.



Block Size: - 7 1/2"

Blocks Needed: - 16

(4 across, 4 down)

HINT: To figure yardages for 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares:

One 40" strip yields 14 squares

1/2 yard yields 84 squares
