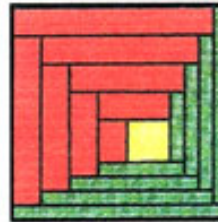

FOLDY STUFF—ROUND CABIN

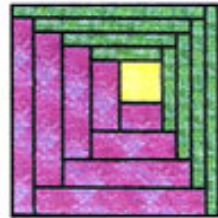

Block Size—7 1/2"
Blocks Needed—32 total
(7 blocks each of 5—(see NOTE*))

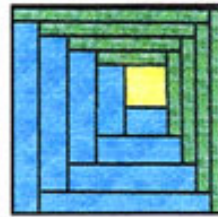


Need 7 blocks EACH



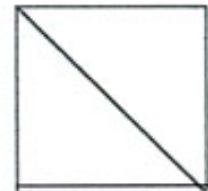
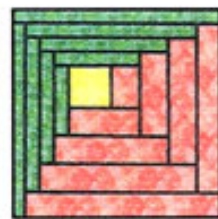
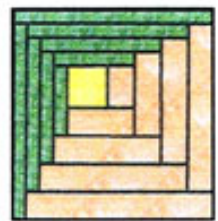
***NOTE**

My instructions are for 7 blocks each of 5 different fabrics. There will be three extra blocks, but it's so much easier this way!! Make pillows with the extras!



YARDAGES

Center square —1/4 yd
Five "peony" fabrics—
3/4 yd EACH
Med. Green—2 1/2 yd
Lt. green-(edges & corners)—3/4 yd
Border—5/8 yd
Muslin—3 7/8 yd (includes blocks and liners for border, edges and corners.
Backing—2 3/4 yd



Cut squares diagonally

CUTTING

Blocks—(See cutting instructions in Round Cabin pattern—use 7 1/2" block)

Cut enough for 7 blocks EACH of 5 different fabrics in "peony" colors—narrow strips of medium green. —OR—Cut enough for 32 blocks in assorted fabrics.

Edge Pieces—cut 7 squares, each 9 1/4" by 9 1/4."
Cut across diagonally to make 14 triangles (see note *)

Corner Pieces—cut 2 squares, each 6 3/4" by 6 3/4."

Cut across diagonally to make 4 corner triangles.
(see note *)

Border—cut 3 1/2" wide (see note *)

Muslin—cut 35 squares, 9" by 9."

*NOTE—cut muslin liners for all edge & corner pieces, plus border.
